

Minimum Eligibility Conditions for Admission In Research Degree (RD) Programmes i.e. MPhil/PhD

A minimum of 55% marks or an equivalent grade in Masters/ PG degree from a recognised University or an equivalent examination in the disciplines specified below:

● Education	MEd, MA (Education), or any other discipline found to be relevant by the University.
● Computer Science & IT	MCA, M Tech, MSc (IT) or any other discipline found to be relevant by the University.
● Environmental Science	Postgraduate (PG) degree in any branch of Science.
● Mathematics	Mathematics, Statistics, Applied Mathematics, Industrial Mathematics, Operations Research and any other discipline found to be relevant by the University.
● Economics	Economics, Industrial Economics, Agriculture Economics, International Economics and any other discipline found to be relevant by the University.
● Social Work	Social Work, Sociology, Psychology, Development Study, Social Anthropology and any other discipline found to be relevant by the University.
● English	English, Comparative Literature, Translation & Interpretation, Linguistics and any other discipline found to be relevant by the University.
● Library Science	Library Science, Library Information System and any other discipline found to be relevant by the University.
● Journalism & Creative Writing	Journalism, Mass Communication, New Media and any other discipline found to be relevant by the University.
