- 2. The Pattern of Written Exam for the post of **Security Officer** is as under:-

Level 1: SECURITY OFFICER

Written Examination shall be of **Objective Type** comprising 100 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) divided into Two Sections (*i.e., Section - A containing 50 questions and Section - B containing 50 questions*), with the following composition, lasting for a duration of 90 Minutes:

Section-A

English: General English, Candidates ability to understand English language, its vocabulary, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms and its correct usage etc. Difficulty level/standard- Graduation.

Maths: Number System, Integers, Average, Ratio & Proportion, Percentage, Simple and Compound Interest, Linear and Quadratic equations, LCM & HCF of Polynomials and their Interrelationship, Theorems of triangle, square, trapezium, circles, their perimeter and area etc.

General Knowledge and General Awareness (Graduation Standard): The questions will include sports, history, culture, geography, economy, general polity, Indian constitution etc. The questions will be such that they do not require a special study of any discipline.

General Intelligence & Reasoning: Difficulty degree/level of Graduation Standard.

Section-B

Security Officer: Domain Knowledge: Multiple Choice Questions on General Security of the University comprising static and mobile security, firefighting and University Act.
