They are also requested to send to this Department (Joint Secretary (Pers.)] a quarterly report containing the following information;-
 - Details of post(s) revived designation, scale of pay, number of posts, date of vacancy and mode of recruitment.
 - II. Functional Justification in brief.
 - III. Details of matching savings provided designation. Scale of pay and the number; and whether filled up posts or vacant and if no, the date of occurrence of vacancy;
 - IV. Confirmation to the effect that the conditions prescribed for revival have been strictly followed.

The Executive Council further desired that this should only be one time exemption on the assurance of timely completion of Annual Accounts in future vide item No. 23.11 of its meeting held on 19.06.2016. As per the instructions issued in this regard by the Ministry of Human Resource Development Govt. of India, vide their D. Each publication shall be evaluated out of 100 marks by each outside subject expert".

Following, the above mentioned Ordinance, Publications submitted by the faculty for promotion under Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) are to be got evaluated by the subject

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM ON THE BUDGET ESTIMATES FOR THE YEAR 2017-18 AND REVISED ESTIMATES FOR 2016-17

The Central University of Himachal Pradesh established under the Central Universities Act 2009 (No. 25 of 2009). It became functional with effect from 20th January, 2010. At present the University is operating its activities from the hired accommodation. It has its headquarter at Dharamshala where the administrative office has been sent up. All the Academic programmes/activities are being operated from Temporary Academic Block, Shahpur, District Kangra, Himachal Pradesh. The objectives of the University as enshrined vide Section 5 of the Act, are as under:

- 1. To disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional and research facilities in such branches of learning as it may deem fit.
- 2. To make special provisions for integrated courses in humanities, social sciences, sciences and technology in its educational programmes.
- 3. To take appropriate measures for promoting innovations in teaching-learning process and inter-disciplinary studies and research.
- 4. To educate and train manpower for the development of the country.
- 5. To establish linkages with industries for the promotion of science and technology.
- 6. To pay special attention to the improvement of the social and economic conditions and welfare of the people, their intellectual, academic and cultural development.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES:

During the year 2016-17, the university laid focus and achieved the following targets:

The University has established a fully functional Temporary Academic Block (TAB) which is strengthened with barest minimum facilities within the available means in terms of space and human resources, so as to run the academic programmes more smoothly. The University has so far launched 02 Certificate Courses, 04 UG 17 PG and 18 RD programmes with an intake of 30 in each PG programme and 10 in each RD programme. The UGC has approved M.Ed integrated programme which could not be launched during the year 2016-17for want of clearance from the National Council of Teacher Education and filling up of the post of Professor. However, the University proposes to launch the said programme during the year 2017-18 with the approval of NCTE. During the year 2015-16, the University has started the following new programmes:

- 1. MA (Sanskrit) with intake of 30.
- 2. BA (Sanskrit/Honour) with intake of 30.
- 3. B.Sc.(Physics/Honours) with intake of 30.
- 4. B.Voc. in Mass Communication under Kaushal Kendra with an intake of 52.
- 5. B.Voc. in Financial & Marketing Services under Kaushal Kendra with an intake of 52.
- 6. Certificate Course in Gujjar History & Culture.
- 7. Certificate Course in Gojjari Bhasha

RECRUITMENT AND APPOINTMENTS

(i) <u>Statutory Officers</u>

The positions of Registrar Finance Officer & Controller of Examination stood filled on regular basis. The process for filling up the post of Librarian is in hand and it is expected that these posts shall be filled up shortly.

(ii) <u>Teaching Faculty</u>

A total of 188 Positions (Teaching) was been sanctioned during both 11th and 12th plan. Out of which 51 positions were sanctioned during the 11th Plan and 137 positions (Teaching) were sanctioned during the 12^h Plan at present 69 (5 Professors, 11 Associate Professors and 53 Assistant Professors) positions have been filled up. The process for filling up the vacant posts is in hand.

(iii) <u>Academic and Non-Teaching</u>

UGC has sanctioned 118 Non- Teaching Posts under various categories, out of which 27 posts has been filled up including the appointments of Registrar and Finance Officer on regular/deputation basis. The process for filling up of remaining positions is in hand and shall be completed in due course of time. The process is underway for advertisement and filling up of these posts.

(iv) <u>Outsourcing of services</u>

The support services like Cook/Kitchen Attendant/Hostel/Mess/Guest House Attendants, Security Guards, Mali, Drivers, and Peon/Office Attendants etc. are being managed through outsourcing as per UGC approval/policy for which approved strength is 75.

PHYSICAL AND ACADEMIC INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPED

Land & Building for Permanent Campuses:

Pending the development of its own infrastructure and permanent campuses, the endeavor of the University was to strengthen and make the Temporary Academic Block fully functional. The University has developed the following facilities:

TEMPORARY HALLS OF RESIDENCE FOR BOYS AND GIRLS

The University has provided hostel facility to its male students from a rented building located in Kangra. The facility is purpose built and accommodates about 110 students of the University in two-bedded room and has facilities for kitchen and dining hall. The Hostel Mess is run on cooperative basis by the residents under the supervision of the University. All students who wish to opt for hostel accommodation have to be members of the hostel mess. Similarly the hostel facility to female students has been provided from a hired building in Dharamshala. The facility is purpose built and accommodates about 60 Girl students of the University.

The University has arranged transport facility by hiring Buses from HRTC to the residents of the two hostels to commute between the Hostel and the Temporary Academic Block.

FUTURE PLANS

The Developmental and Construction work could not be commenced during the year 2016-17 for want of possession of land. However, the process for appointment of Project Management Consultants has been completed and the process for appointment of Architects for designing of the planned buildings is in hand so that the actual developmental and construction work(s) could be taken up immediately after getting the physical possession of land. As soon as the possession of land is given, the following developmental activities shall be taken up:

I. CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT:

The University is hopeful that it shall get the possession of land during the year 2017-18 and thus expects that the developmental and construction works shall commence this Year. The University plans to undertake the following developmental works immediately after getting the possession of land:

- Providing and fixing the boundary pillars at the two campuses
- Construction of boundary walls at both the campuses
- Levelling of land
- Construction of internal roads
- Augmentation and Providing Water and Elect. Lines/connections

II. CONSTRUCTION OF BUILDINGS

The University aims at its first stage to take up the construction of the following buildings:

- Administrative buildings to house the offices of the Vice-Chancellor, Registrar, Finance Officer and the Controller of Examination.
- Academic/School Buildings to accommodate the academic programmes of the University with all module and teaching aids.
- Residential buildings for the Vice-Chancellor, statutory officers, faculty and other staff

• Halls of Residences for the students

III. CENTRAL FACILITIES

The following central facilities are also proposed to be taken up during the year 2017-18 depending upon the availability of funds:

- Construction of Library & Information Resource Centre
- Construction of Hostels for Boys and Girls
- Construction of Guest House.
- Make available additional temporary accommodation for the offices of Registrar, Finance Officer and Controller of Examination, on hire basis or through construction of transitory modular structures.

IV. STRENGTHENING OF FACILITIES AT TEMPORARY ACADEMIC BLOCK:

The University does not have permanent campuses and infrastructure. The University is striving hard and it is its earnest Endeavour to provide state of art facilities to the students and faculty within the limited available resources in terms of space/buildings to accommodate the maximum possible activities.

The University plans to further improve upon and strengthen the existing facilities at TAB, as under:

- Examination section: Providing facilities for strong room for keeping examination and other confidential records.
- Establishment of laboratories
- Strengthening of library facilities procurement of books, software's, eresources/journals.
- Common facilities such as setting up a mini gym/activity rooms/playground with skeleton facilities for such games as badminton, volleyball and basketball, providing canteen facility.

E-Governance Initiative

- **ERP Initiative:** The University is presently actively working in the direction of implementation of total solution for Enterprise-wide Resource Planning for complete office automation and e-governance.
- Providing additional students bus facility
- Providing medical facilities at TAB and hostels of the students.
- Providing university website facility accessible to Persons with Disabilities
- Establishment of UGC Schemes such as Equal Opportunities Cell, Remedial Coaching Schemes for SC/ST/OBC, minorities, Coaching Schemes for Entry into Services for SC/ST/OBC, minorities Community students, Coaching Schemes for SC/ST/OBC, minority community candidates to prepare for NET, SET,

Scheme for Differently Abled Persons viz.

- (i) Teacher Preparation in Special Education (TEPSE) and
- (ii) Higher Education for persons with special needs (HEPSN).

SALIENT FEATURES OF BUDGET ESTIMATES

The Budget Estimates for the year 2017-18 and Revised Estimates for the year 2016-17 have been prepared by the Finance Officer of the University as per provisions of Statutes 7(7)(c), under the direction and supervision of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor.

Revised Estimates for 2016-17:

While the Actual for the year 2015-16 are based on actual receipt and expenditure as per Audited Annual Accounts, the Revised Estimates of Receipt for the year 2016-17 have been based on the actual flow of grants and internal income of the university and for Expenditure these are based on actual expenditure upto 31.12.2016, for revenue and capital items.

Budget Estimates for 2017-18:

The Budget Estimates for the year 2017-18 have been prepared keeping in view the pay hike granted to Non-Teaching Staff and in 7th CPC and expected pay hike to be granted to the teaching staff including provision for the vacant Teaching and Non-Teaching positions. It may be mentioned here that 119 Nos positions of Teaching Staff and 91 positions of Non-Teaching Staff are in the process of being filled shortly.

Giving a brief Review ,UGC under revised 12th Plan allocatedRs.234.50 crores for CUHP. Out of the revised 12th Plan allocation of Rs.234.50 crores, a sum of Rs.23.50 Crores was allocated for Grant In Aid (under Maintenance Head 31) and Rs 60.00 crores Grant In Aid (under Salary Head 35) was allocated under recurring (contingency and salary) out of which only a sum of Rs.52.74 crores (18.64 Crores GIA under Head 31 and 34.10 Crores GIA under Head 35) had been released till the year 2016-17.

It is informed that while formulating the Budget Estimates for the year 2017-18, irrespective of the staff already recruited , 6months provision for all the teaching/non-teaching positions proposed to be filled being created during XI Plan and XII Plan have been taken into consideration.

Similarly under the Capital Budget an allocation if Rs 151.00 Crores was allocated under Creation of Assets Head 35 (non-recurring for creation of assets) and only 30.00 crores were released till 2016-17. The estimates under this head for Budget 2017-18 have been prepared keeping in view the estimated costs of creating basic assets, a budget estimates Rs.154.40crores is proposed from UGC for the year 2017-18. It is pertinent to mention that it exceeds the 12th plan allocation of 121.00 crores by Rs 33.40 Crores reason being the price increase since 2012 when these estimates were initially prepared.

Earmarked Grant (JRF& Non NET Fellowship)

The Grants received as specific earmarked grants, from Govt. of India and UGC have been shown in the Budget Estimates for the year 2017-18separately under Part II.

Provision for Leave Salary and Pension Contribution/Retirement benefits

The Budget Estimates for the year 2017-18 also contain a token provision for leave salary and pension contribution/retirement benefits in respect of the members of the staff who are on deputation from other organizations as leave salary/pension contributions are payable to their parent departments Part III.

Provision for Deposits and Earmarked Funds

The Designated/Earmarked/Endowment Funds maintained by the University have been shown in the Budget Estimates for the year 2017-18 separately under Part IV.

Accordingly, the Budget Estimates for the year 2017-18, have been formulated in the following parts:

PART-I: Plan General Development (Maintenance) Scheme	Deals with receipts and expenditure on account ofPlan (maintenance) Grant-in-aid General (31), Grant-in-aid Salary (36) and Grant-in-aid for Creation of Assets (35) Capital Account.

The Budget Estimates under **Plan General Development (Salary & Recurring)** for the year 2017-18 are proposed keeping in view the requirement of grant of **Rs. 3000.76** Lakhs under Recurring and Salary Head, unspent balance of **Rs. 1489.02**Lakhs and an expected internal income of **Rs. 418.30** lakhs for the year 2017-18. The total receipts under Plan General Development (Salary & Recurring) for the year 2017-18 are estimated to be approx. **Rs. 4908.08** Lakhs.

Similarly under **Plan General Development (Capital)** the budget estimates are proposed to be tune of Rs.**18,551.61** Lakhs keeping in mind the proposed unspent balance of **3111.34** Lakhs of 2016-17 and Grant of Rs**15,440.27** Lakhs from UGC.

Thus the total Budget Estimates for the year 2017-18 have been proposed at **Rs. 24,149.69** lakhs and have been proposed after keeping provision for meeting the requirements of the University.

The financial year 2016-17 started with an unspent balance under head **Plan General Development Head Maintenance Scheme Rs. 1877.30** Lakh (opening as on

01/04/2016), upto Dec 2016 (i.e 31/12/2016) a sum of **Rs. 157.34** lakh has been received as internal income and an amount sanctioned by UGC amounting to **Rs. 1200.00** Lakh (*under Plan General Development (maintenance) i.e Salary Head 36*) had been received during the year 2016-17. Thus the total availability of funds under Plan General Development, during the year 2016-17as on 31/12/2016 is **Rs.3234.65** lakhs.

Similarly under Plan General Development Capital grant, the availability of funds during 2016-17 is expected **Rs. 3221.34** Lakhs (opening as on 01/04/2016) as unspent balance of previous year.
