




Small and Marginal Farmers in India

87% of the Indian Farmers are small and marginal farmers having less than 3 acres of land and a family income of less than Rs. 6,500 per month.

58% of the rural households depend on agriculture as principal means of livelihood.

Farming on small plots of land is economically unviable for them. Low margins and unpredictable weather worsens the situation pushing them into vicious cycles of money lenders and crop failures.



Struggling Producer Organizations

Currently, there are more than **6000** FPOs in the country, however, only **14%** have a paid-up capital of **Rs. 10 Lakh** or more while **49%** have a paid-up capital of **Rs. 1 Lakh** or less.

Ministry of Corporate Affairs struck off **445** producer companies (PCs) due undercapitalisation in the PCs as well as their inability to do business activities.

A study done on FPOs promoted by SFAC showed that **74%** of the total FPOs didn't have access to finance from banks while **89%** didn't have access to warehouse facilities. **79%** didn't licenses to procure bulk input.


Transforming India Initiative - Reimagine Farmer Enterprises
