# Extension of the last date for submission of online applications for the Common University Entrance Test (UG)-2022

National Testing Agency (NTA) will be conducting the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) (UG)-2022 in July 2022 in the computer based mode for admission to the UG courses in Central Universities and other Participating Institutions (PI), for the Academic Year 2022-23 in the first fortnight of July 2022.

Registration for the CUET (UG) - 2022 is in progress at https://cuet.samarth.ac.in

In continuation of the Public Notice dated 06.04.2022 and pursuant to representations from the candidates, it has been decided to extend the last date for submission of online application forms for CUET (UG) - 2022.

The last date stands extended as under:

Further, it is hereby informed as follows:

- Eligibility/mapping of the tests offered under CUET (UG)-2022 was revised by few Universities/PIs after commencement of registration. The revised mapping was also displayed on the NTA website( <a href="https://cuet.samarth.ac.in">https://cuet.samarth.ac.in</a>).
- Some courses offered by few Universities/PIs were dropped by them, after commencement of registration, due to unavoidable circumstances. Such information was also displayed on the NTA website( https://cuet.samarth.ac.in ).

In such cases, it is likely that candidates may have submitted their applications selecting the tests as per the initial mapping and/or applied for courses which are no more on offer by the Universities/PIs.

Hence, all applicants who have already submitted their applications for CUET (UG)-2022 are advised as follows:

- a) Re-visit the website of the University/PI where they want admission and re-confirm whether the courses in which they want admission are still on offer by the University/PI concerned and
- b) Re-visit the mapping of the courses/tests on the NTA website <a href="https://cuet.samarth.ac.in">https://cuet.samarth.ac.in</a> and reconfirm that the tests opted by them in their application form are in conformity with the tests that they are required to apply for in CUET (UG)-2022.

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With a view to enable applicants to make changes in the tests that they had selected, arising due to changes mentioned above or otherwise, a facility for editing the tests selected, has been made available at https://cuet.samarth.ac.in.

Candidates, can visit the said website and make the desired changes in the "Tests" opted at any time before the last date for submission of application forms and also pay the differential fee, if any, that may be applicable, arising on account of such changes.

In case, arising out of such correction, any fee is due for refund (as in the case of their moving from two Slots to a single Slot), the excess fee paid will be refunded, w ithin six weeks after the hosting of Admit Cards, after verification.

This editing facility is confined to "Tests" opted and does not extend to cover other fields. Candidates can also select more Universities/PIs or more courses.

This editing facility is in addition to the "Correction Window" which will be made available as stated above.


CUET (UG) -2022 will provide a single-window opportunity to students seeking admission to the Central Universities (CUs) across the country for various Undergraduate Programmes.

CUET (UG) – 2022 is a bouquet of tests in various Languages, Domain-specific Subjects, and General Test. Candidates can select any one or more of the tests offered under CUET (UG) - 2022, as per the requirements of the University/ies where admission is sought.

The CUET (UG) – 2022 will be conducted in 13 languages, i.e. English, Hindi, Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, and Urdu.

Subject: Conduct of the Common University Entrance Test CUET (UG)-2022 for Under Graduate Programmes in Central Universities for the Academic Session 2022-23

The National Testing Agency (NTA) is established by Ministry of Education, MoE (Earlier known as Ministry of Human Resource Development-MHRD) as an independent/ autonomous, self-reliant and self-sustained premier testing organization.

National Testing Agency has been entrusted with the responsibility of conducting the Undergraduate entrance tests for all the Central Universities (CUs) for the academic session 2022-2023. CUET will provide a single window opportunity to students to seek admission in any of the Central Universities (CUs) across the country.

The CUET (UG) - 2022 will be conducted in **Computer Based Test (CBT) Mode**. The aspirants who desire to appear for the test, may refer to the Information Bulletin for admission to **Undergraduate programmes** of the desired **Central Universities (CUs)** for admission into the **Undergraduate Programmes**.

The details of the programmes offered by Central Universities (CUs) are being made available on their respective websites.

Online Application Forms for Undergraduate Programmes will open from 02.04.2022, the link for the same will be made available on the official website <a href="https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/">https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/</a>. Candidates who wish to appear for CUET (UG) – 2022 are advised to go through the required eligibility of the desired University/ Universities for selecting the options from UG Programmes being offered. The Application will be open from 02.04.2022 to 30.04.2022.

Examination Structure for CUET (UG) - 2022:

CUET (UG) – 2022 will consist of the following 4 Sections:

- ➤ Section IA 13 Languages
- ➤ Section IB 20 Languages
- $\triangleright$  Section II 27 Domain specific Subjects
- > Section III General Test

Choosing options from each Section is not mandatory. Choices should match the requirements of the desired University.

- A Candidate can choose a maximum of any 3 languages from Section IA and Section IB taken together. However, the third language chosen needs to be in lieu of 6<sup>th</sup> domain specific Subject chosen by the candidate as applicable (so the maximum number of tests to be taken remains 9 only i.e. 2 Languages+6 Domain Specific Subjects+1 General Test OR 3 Languages+5 Domain Specific Subjects+1 General Test: flexibility being provided to help a candidate apply for many Universities depending on their eligibility conditions).
- Section II offers 27 Subjects, out of which a candidate may choose a maximum of 6 Subjects.







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- Section III comprises General Test.
- For choosing Languages from Section IA and IB and domain specific Subjects from Section II and General Test under Section III, the Candidate must refer to the requirements of his/her intended University.

Level of questions for CUET (UG) -2022:

All questions in various testing areas will be benchmarked at the level of Class XII only. Students having studied Class XII Board syllabus would be able to do well in CUET (UG) – 2022.

### Number of attempts:

If any University permits students of previous years of class XII to take admission in the current year also, such students would also be eligible to appear in CUET (UG) - 2022.

#### Choice of Languages and Subjects:

Generally the languages/subjects chosen should be the ones that a student has opted in his latest Class XII Board examination. However, if any University permits any flexibility in this regards, the same can be exercised under CUET (UG) -2022 also. Candidates must carefully refer to the eligibility requirements of various Central Universities in this regard. Moreover, if the subject to be studied in the Undergraduate course is not available in the list of 27 Domain Specific Subject being offered, the Candidate may choose the Subject closest to his/her choice for e.g. For Biochemistry the candidate may choose Biology.

#### Schedule of Examination

Examination will be conducted on multiple days in two shifts, depending on the number of Candidates and Languages/Tests taken by them.




