About the Workshop

Indian higher education system is encircled by several heterogeneous conditions such as infrastructural, social, locational, regional, economical and aspirational issues. Due to these issues, maintaining the quality of research has always been a challenge. Many of the nations are trying to reinforce the quality of research and time has come when India too needs to prioritize it. The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 intends to revamp the whole education system including research. The NEP 2020 envisions the establishment of a National Research Foundation (NRF) with the aim of allowing a culture of research to permeate our universities.

However, quality research is possible only when the researchers undergo systematic training in research methodology. Research methodology is a structured framework of conducting research in order to address various issues and to solve problems in a scientific way. Therefore, it is imperative for the researchers to understand research methodology and applications of contemporary statistical techniques for conducting research.

In recognition of the need for reorienting and upgrading the research abilities of research scholars of social sciences and inter-disciplinary areas, the Central University of Himachal Pradesh proposes to organize an intensive ten-day's workshop on Research Methodology with an object of enhancing research skills of the scholars and to provide them a unique opportunity to get themselves trained in the methodology of research. Research not only generates useful insight and confidence but also acts as a stimulant for academic growth. Sound conceptual understanding of various research methods, research instruments, tools and techniques is an essential prerequisite for conducting empirical research. Research is the systematic and objective process of gathering, recording and analyzing data for taking appropriate & meaningful decisions. It connotes patient study and scientific investment, wherein the researcher takes a more careful look at data to discover all that could be known more deeply about the subject under study.

For undergoing high quality research and writing good research papers, one requires to collect, interpret and logically document the information. The art of drawing coherent conclusions, supported by appropriate research tools and reference citation is vital for quality research work. Keeping in view the importance of **Research Methodology Course (RMC)** on Research Methodology, aims to explore the basic dimensions of research and the concomitant need for

participants to rethink about the assumptions that underlie historic paradigms of research in the field of social sciences and other allied disciplines.

The Research Methodology Course (RMC) is designed to offer the participants with a handson approach to conduct research. On completion of the Research Methodology Course (RMC),
participants are likely to have developed the skills to review the literature, develop hypotheses,
frame research design, formulate a research proposal, to develop suitable Research Methods &
Data Analytical Tools and identify sampling techniques and Qualitative & Quantitative research
and relevance of the tools for data collection, Methods of Qualitative Research and analysis etc.
The ten-day Research Methodology Course (RMC) will help the participants to know the
theoretical as well as practical inputs of research.

Objectives of the Research Methodology Course (RMC)

The proposed Research Methodology Course intends to strengthen the academic talent pool of the participants who are M.Phil. or PhD Scholars enrolled in any recognized universities. The aim is to reach out to students from different social science disciplines to impart an inter-disciplinary approach of capacity building. The workshop focuses on addressing the challenges faced by the researchers by introducing students to mixed methods of research. This will enable them in identifying and understanding the techniques required for their research. The major emphasis has been given to tools of data collection involved in qualitative approaches and mixed method. Atlas is a recent technique which is much used by the researchers involved in qualitative research hence it is included within the sessions. Similarly, the workshop aims to train students in publishing quality research papers in Scopus indexed and High Impact Factor Journals which is a mandatory requirement for researchers who aim to pick up teaching as their career option.

The key objectives of the course are:

- To understand some basic concepts of research and its methodology and its techniques.
- To provide an overview of Contemporary Research Methodology and Data Analysis in the field of Social Sciences and allied disciplines.
- To provide the platform for discussion on the methodological requirements of research and to simulate & capture new approaches.
- To enable researchers, irrespective of their discipline, in developing the most appropriate

methodology for their research studies.

- To develop suitable Research Methods & Data Analytical Tools;
- To make them familiar with the art of using different research methods and techniques.
- To provide the platform for discussion on the statistical requirements of the research.
- To train and inculcate the skills for Data Analytics.
- To write a good research paper.
- To prepare a project proposal (to undertake a project).
- To learn organize and conduct research (advanced project) in a more appropriate manner.
- To write a research report and thesis.
- To make aware the participants about latest trends in social science research discipline.

- Research Integrity, Ethics and Anti Plagiarism Rules.
- Report/ Thesis Writing.
- Writing and Publishing Research Papers in High Impact Factor and Scopus Journals.
- Funding Avenues in Social Sciences Research.

- Applicant should also submit a synopsis or brief note on the research area of their interest with not more than 1500-2000 words along with the application form.
- Selected candidates would be informed through Email (icssrmc2022@gmail.com).
- There is no registration fee.

Intake & Selection Criteria

The number of seats for the course is limited to 30. Those who have attended any workshop on Research Methodology sponsored either by UGC or ICSSR are not eligible to apply for this programme. The selection committee will select the participants for the workshop after reviewing the application. The guidelines of ICSSR shall be strictly followed for selection and the conduction of the programme. It is desirable for all the selected participants to have their own laptop for the classes.

Venue & Certificate of Participation

The workshop will be conducted at Central University of Himachal Pradesh, Dharamshala.

Only candidates with 100% attendance will be eligible to receive the certificate of participation.

ACCOMMODATION & TRAVEL ALLOWANCE

Accommodation will be provided only to outstation participants in University Guest House/Hotels on sharing basis from July 6, 2022 (evening) to July 17, 2022(morning). Travel allowance by shortest distance (bus, train fare or sleeper class only) will be reimbursed to the outstation participants after submitting original tickets.

ESSENTIAL CONDITIONS

Candidates having knowledge of basic statistics and Microsoft excel will be preferred. Selected candidates would be informed through Email or Phone. Further, it is desirable for all the selected participants to bring their own laptop for the hands-on practice sessions. Selected participants are requested to develop a full length research paper (of 3000-4000 words in Times New Roman, 12

font size, spacing 1.5,) on any one of the government flagship programmes and their effectiveness, like, (I) Skill Development, (II) Cashless Economy, (III) Ayushman Bharat Yojana, (IV) Make in India, (V) Digital India, (VI) Jan Dhan Yojana, (VII) Beti Bachao Beti Padhao, (VIII) Standup India, (IX) Swacch Bharat Abhiyaan and (X) MGNREGA etc and have present it at the final day of Ten Days Research Methodology Course for M.Phil/Ph.D./Research Scholar in Social Sciences.
